

Swedish Aspen

Quaking Aspen

(*Populus tremuloides* 'Erecta')



Native to the forests of Sweden, this slender tree is great for smaller spaces, screens and along drives. A great substitute for columnar poplars for it is more resistant to cankers and longer lived. Dark green leaves have a lighter silvery-green underside providing both visual interest and soothing sound in a breeze. Prefers a rich, well-drained, moist soil but is very adaptable. Displays more reds in autumn color than Quaking Aspen.
